- 1. Total applicable taxable gross receipts, covering a complete month's sales, are to be reported by the 20th day of the succeeding month.
 - A) Gross receipts received by restaurants, cafes, cafeterias, delis, drive-in restaurants, carry out restaurants, convenience stores, grocery store delis and bakeries, catering and all other establishments in the City of Bella Vista engaged in the selling of prepared food and non-alcoholic beverages for on or off premises consumption shall be taxed at 1%, but such tax shall not apply to such gross receipts or gross proceeds of fraternal organizations qualified under Section 501(c)(3) of the Federal Internal Revenue Code.
 - B) Questions concerning taxable items are addressed on a case-by case basis. Please contact the A & P Commission at info@discoverbellavistaar.com for assistance.
- 2. This tax is authorized by Arkansas Code Annotated § 26-75-602(c)(2) and City Ordinance 2017-15 implemented by the Bella Vista City Council in April of 2017, and is to be collect in the same manner and at the same time as the tax levied by the Arkansas Gross Receipts Act.
- 3. For payments made after the deadline, add the 5% penalty as instructed on this form.
- 4. Failure to report and remit tax according to the above guidelines will result in collection and penalty procedures pursuant to Bella Vista City Ordinance 16-7.
